

APPENDIX “B”

Pursuant to the Definitions of Tourism
Attractions as Identified in the Tourism
Exemption Regulations Under the Retail
Business Holidays Act.

The City of Orillia is deemed to be a year-round tourism attraction.

Natural and outdoor attractions include the City’s waterfront, including Couchiching Beach and Centennial Parks, the Port of Orillia, the Lightfoot and Millennium trails and the Heritage Downtown Improvement Area.

Historical attractions include the Champlain Monument, the many Historical buildings designated under the Ontario Heritage Act and included in a Historical Walking Tour.

Cultural attractions including the Orillia Opera House, the Leacock Museum and the Orillia Museum of Art and History.

Community events and festivals include the Orillia Winter Carnival (winter), the Orillia Perch Festival (spring), the Mariposa Folk Festival (summer) and the Orillia Jazz Festival (fall).
