## **Voters with Special Needs**

- Voting locations are selected to ensure that the mobility needs of all voters are met. If a voter attends a voting location but is unable to leave his/her vehicle, an Election Official may attend at the vehicle.
- Voters can request a magnifying sheet from an Election Official in order to read the ballot.
- Voters can request that someone assist them in marking the ballot.
- Voters can appoint someone as an interpreter to assist them in the voting process.
- Voters living in a retirement or nursing home may be able to vote in the location where they live if this location has 50 or more beds. Mobile voting stations are scheduled for a minimum of two hours on voting day.
- Young voters who are not on the Voters' List and who do not have identification can sign an oath of qualification and vote.
- Homeless voters who are not on the Voters' List and do not have identification can sign an oath of qualification and vote.
- Voters who know in advance that they will not be able to vote on Voting Day or at one of the Advance Votes can appoint someone to be their *Proxy Voter* to vote on their behalf.
