

# Disc Golf Rules and Terminology

## OBJECT:

One point is counted each time the disc is thrown and when a penalty is incurred. Have fun and play the course from the beginning to the end in the fewest throws.

## TEE OFF:

Tee throws must be released from behind the designated tee area. Children may release their Tee throws 20 to 30 feet in front of the designated area on all holes except # 4 and # 7.

## LIE:

The spot where the disc lands: mark with a mini disc or some other item.

## THROWING ORDER:

The lowest score on the previous hole tees off first. After the tee off, the player whose lie is farthest from the target throws first.

## FAIRWAY THROWS:

Must be made from the lie. A run-up and follow through is permitted.

## PUTT:

Within 10 yards of the target, a player may not step past the lie when attempting a putt throw.

## COMPLETION OF HOLE:

The hole is complete when the disc is in the basket supported by the chains.

## UNPLAYABLE LIE:

Any disc that comes to rest above the ground (in a tree) is considered an unplayable lie. The new lie will be directly underneath the unplayable lie (NO PENALTY). Relocate to avoid damage to vegetation.

## OUT OF BOUNDS:

A throw that lands **OUT OF BOUNDS** must be played from the point where the disc went into the out-of-bounds area. **(1 throw penalty)**

## COURTESY:

Do not throw until the players or park users are out of range. Please pick up your trash and help new players play by the rules.

**Remember the most important rule: HAVE FUN**
