RE: ZONING BY-LAW AMENDMENT AND DRAFT PLAN
OF CONDOMINIUM**

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the City of Orillia has received applications from Aziz Amiri, Crystal Group Inc. (Agent: Morgan Planning and Development Inc.) for a proposed Zoning By-law Amendment (File No. D14-771) and for a Draft Plan of Common Elements Condominium (File No. 43CD -10-602) pursuant to the provisions of the Planning Act as follows:

Description of the Lands:

The subject properties are located on the west side of West Street North, south of Fittons Road West and north of Calverley Street and are known municipally as 385 and 387 West Street North.

Purpose and Effect of the Proposed Zoning By-law Amendment No. D14-771 and Draft Plan of Common Elements Condominium No. 43CD-10-602 (385 and 387 West Street North):

The lands in question are designated "Living Area" in the City's Official Plan and currently zoned "Fourth Density Residential (R4)", in part, and "Fourth Density Residential Exception Ten (R4-10)", in part, under Zoning By-law 2005-72, as amended.

The Zoning By-law Amendment proposes to rezone the subject properties to the "First Density Multiple Residential Exception (RM1-XX)" Zone to permit up to eighteen (18) Townhouse Dwelling Units with a minimum lot area of 164 sq.m. per unit. The proposed Draft Plan for Common Elements Condominium will provide for the creation of up to eighteen (18) Freehold Townhouse Dwelling Units on a private road to be owned by the Condominium Corporation.

Related Applications:

There are no other related applications under the Planning Act in process which apply to the subject properties.

Oral and Written Submissions – Appeal:

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a Public Meeting or does not make a written submission to the Council of the Corporation of the City of Orillia before:

- (i) the proposed Zoning By-law Amendment is passed; and/or
- (ii) the approval authority gives or refuses to give approval to the Draft Plan of Condominium;

the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the Council of the Corporation of the City of Orillia to the Ontario Municipal Board.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a Public Meeting, or make a written submission to the Council of the Corporation of the City of Orillia before:

- (i) the proposed Zoning By-law Amendment is passed; and/or
- (ii) the approval authority gives or refuses to give approval to the Draft Plan of Condominium;

the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Municipal Board unless, in the opinion of the Board, there are reasonable grounds to do so.

Individuals who make written submissions should be aware that their submission and any personal information in their correspondence will become part of the public record and made available to the Applicant, Committee and Council.

GARBAGE TAGS - NEXT MAILING

Effective July 1, 2010, residents and businesses of Orillia will be issued 30 garbage tags for the period July 1, 2010 to June 30, 2011. The reduction from 40 tags corresponds to recent improvements to the City's diversion programs including the new Green Bin program and the Fibre Box program whereby residents can use one Recycling Box for containers and another Recycling Box for mixed paper. Fully utilizing the City's new Green Bin program and the Recycling Box program can cut your waste by 45%! So save your tags.

OPERATION OF SNOWMOBILES

Chapter 667 of the City of Orillia's Municipal Code prohibits snowmobiles from operating on any sidewalk, boulevard, park, prohibited trail or highway or on private property (without consent). Snowmobiles are also prohibited from operating between 11:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.



On those streets where snowmobiles are permitted, they are only allowed for the purpose of traveling from the operator's residence to a Council approved trail or a lake and to return from such trail or lake to the operator's residence. Please also note that the Motorized Snow Vehicles Act, prohibits snowmobiles from operating at a greater rate of speed than 20 km/hr in a 50 km/hr zone.
